PUBLIC COMMENT

Persons addressing the Commission shall state his/her name and address and may speak for three (3) minutes unless extended for one (1) additional minute by the Mayor. The Commission shall determine the appropriate time, prior to the vote, for the public to speak. For consent agenda items, the public shall be given an opportunity to speak prior to the approval of the consent agenda. The Commission may, by majority vote, determine that public input on an agenda item be tabled to a future meeting so long as the vote on the agenda item take place at the future meeting and that the public input take place prior to the Commission making any decision.
